Dunking Booth

Towing

Requires a 2" Towing Ball

Make sure all feet are raised and safety pins placed in legs and hitch.

Attach safety chains to vehicle.

Do not move unit with water in it.

Make wider than normal turns.

Set up

Place in level location where the Dunking Booth will be used.

Place wheel chocks both in front and behind wheels

Remove safety pins.

Loosen T bolts on legs, legs will drop to the ground, level and tighten, place safety pins back in legs to keep from loosing.

Close water release valve located under unit.

Place garden hose into unit through cage; fill with water (approximately 30-45 minutes) to the bottom of target arms.

Fold out fencing (to catch the balls) and place pipe (located at the hinge area of the fence) into the pipe holders located at the end of the fence frame. This pipe does not need to be driven into the ground.

Operation

There is a reset mechanism inside the unit. Pinch point Do not try to reset the unit while sitting on it.

Do not use until water level is at the target arms.

Tension Adjustment screw is located under the seat. Adjust if it is sensitive or not sensitive enough.

Use steps located inside the unit to get back up to the seat.

Rules

The most common use is 3 soft balls per person, standing about 20 feet away for adults, 15 feet for children. You may choose different distances. Six Softballs are issued with each unit.

End of Event

Open water release valve.

Close the fence panels and replace the pipe into the holders, latch fence panels together.

When empty, remove safety pins, raise rear legs, place unit on towing vehicle remove safety pins, raise front legs, and replace safety pins including the one in the hitch.

Do not move Dunking Booth with water in it.

Do not leave Dunking Booth unattended, potential accidental Drowning

No one under 16 allowed to be dunked.

YOUR EVENT COORDINATOR AND YOUR EVENT PERSONAL ARE RESPONSIBLE TO MAKE SURE NO SMALL CHILDREN GO INTO THE DUNKING BOOTH ONCE IT IS FILLED UP. THE DUNKING BOOTH MUST BE WATCHED AT ALL TIMES ONCE FILLED.
